

A new 5 year project - 'ASOSS' - Aphasia Surrey One Stop Shop supported by a grant from the Big Lottery Fund

The main focus of this exciting 5 year project is to help build the confidence and self esteem of people with aphasia, through increased participation and engagement in life.

It recognises that people with aphasia recover and adjust at different rates and that many individuals can respond to additional support at certain points on this journey, even years after the onset of their aphasia.

We will continue to work with groups, supporting our members to communicate using whatever means they have available to them. However, within the ASOSS project we will also help individual members work towards realistic goals, aiming to build confidence and encourage greater levels of participation.

We expect members' goals to range from small (e.g. undertaking a particular responsibility within group meetings) to something much more challenging such as taking on volunteer work in the community.
