Conversation Partners

Six-session course for couples where one member has aphasia. Led by two Speech and Language Therapists.



iPad Course

Five-session course led by a Speech and Language Therapist, supporting people with aphasia to access their iPad using a person-centred approach.



Learning to live with Aphasia

Weekly sessions run over one year for people coming to terms with aphasia, adapting to life after initial rehabilitation. Led by a Speech and Language Therapist focusing on functional communication strategies.



Primary Progressive Aphasia (PPA)

Our specialist Speech and Language Therapists offer a programme of courses and on-going support sessions for couples living with this condition.
