As a result of receiving support from Dyscover:

- *81% of respondents reported a better understanding of Primary Progressive Aphasia*
- *78% said they had developed practical strategies to support more effective communication.*

When asked what they valued most about Dyscover's support 97% highlighted the fact that sessions:

- *are delivered by a specialist Speech and Language Therapist*
- *are personalised*
- *are available over the long term.*

*Overall, respondents gave Dyscover's PPA service a satisfaction rating of 4.73 **out of 5**.*

Our PPA service is certainly getting busier!

*Between 1 April 2025 and 31 March 2026, we received **83** new referrals.
This is **59%** more than last year and **108%** more than were received in 2023-24.
This year we delivered **115** one-to-one sessions and led **14** small group sessions.*

Hospital Saturday Fund (HSF) have given us a small grant of £2K to help grow the PPA team.

The Hospital Saturday Fund is a registered charity whose aims are to provide assistance for registered health charities, hospices, medical organisations and individuals with a medical condition or disability.
